*The following are some ways to help your student(s) with test anxiety:*

*Please make sure that your student attends school on a regular basis so that they are exposed to the schoolwork that is covered in the exam. In addition, students will do better on the assignment if they complete their assignment.*

*Share with your children that it is normal to be nervous, but to just do their best. It is helpful if your children develop a positive attitude towards test taking, help them develop a “can do” attitude. Teach them to take their time on the tests, rushing through the test could create an increase in anxiety! Taking deep breaths calms students down. Encourage them to do their best work.*


